

Faux Pinwheel Card

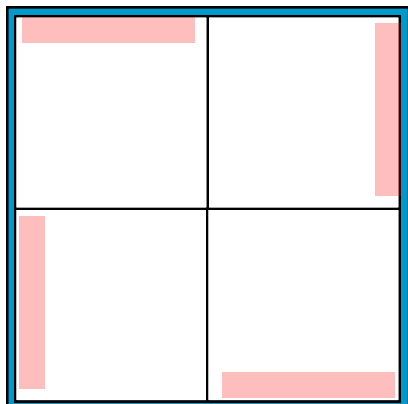
Materials for Pinwheel

One 3" x 5-1/2" piece of double sided Designer Series Paper
Paper
Two 2-7/8" squares of coordinating solid card stock
1-1/4" Square Punch

Instructions for Pinwheel

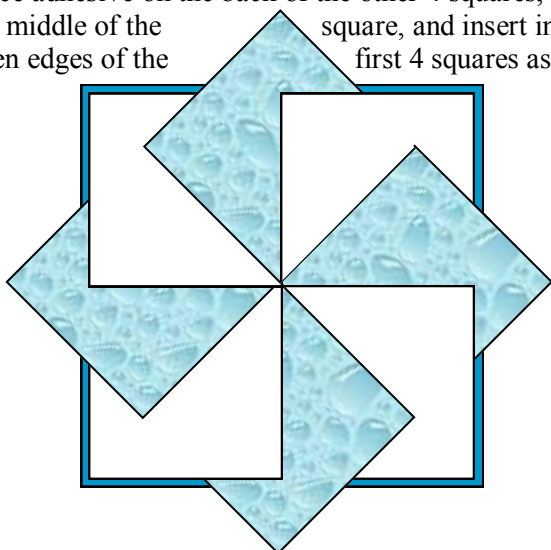
Punch 8 squares from the Designer Series Paper.
Using the following instructions carefully, adhere 4 of the squares, using the color from side 1 of the Designer Series Paper, to one of the 2-7/8" squares of solid card stock.

Place Adhesive on the back of the squares as shown by the

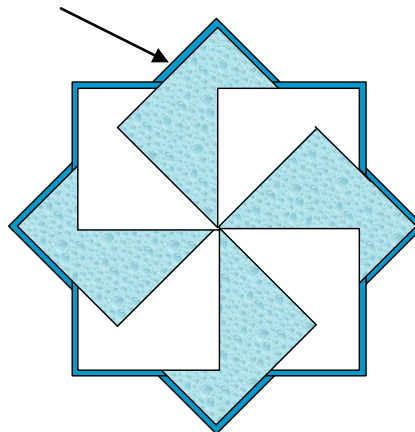


pink rectangles

Using Side 2 of the Designer Series Paper as the front, place adhesive on the back of the other 4 squares, towards the middle of the square, and insert into the open edges of the first 4 squares as shown.



Adhere the whole piece to the second 2-7/8" square of coordinating card stock so that it mats the contrasting colors of Designer Series Paper.



Now you can use this Faux Pinwheel as a central element on a card or scrapbook page. Here is a card made using the 2010 Occasions Mini Catalog **specialty paper set, Sending Love.**

Embellishments used:

- **Flower Brads** (Pretty in Pink)
- Small circle of **Real Red Card Stock** punched with the **Crop-a-dile** and adhered with **Tombow glue**
- **Pretty in Pink Taffeta Ribbon**
- Greeting from the stamp set, **Teeny Tiny Wishes**, punched with the **Word Window Punch**.



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
