

Tea Bag Card—2010 Summer Mini Catalog Version

For that tea lover in your life—and a great Get Well Gift as well!



Supplies Needed

- Designer Series Paper
 1. 6" x 6-1/2" (for tea bag pockets)
 2. Scrap (for tea cup)
- Solid Color Card Stock
 1. 7-3/8" x 3-1/4" (outside of card)
 2. 3" x 3-1/4" (to decorate front of card)
 3. Scraps (for Saucer and Tea Cup Handle)
- 1/4" Grosgrain Ribbon—16"
- Oval Punches: Small, Large and Wide
- 1-1/4" Circle Punch
- Sticky Strip

Supplies Suggested

- Stamp Set *Favorite Thoughts*
- Scallop Edge Corner Punch
- Sizzix Big Shot and Stampin' Up! Texturz Plate

Instructions

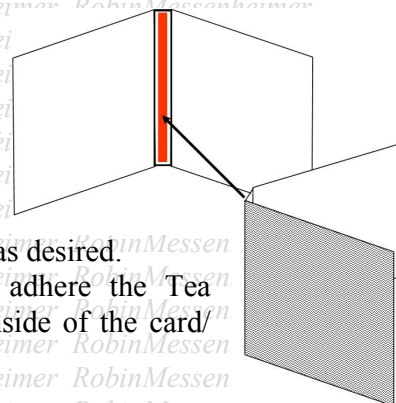
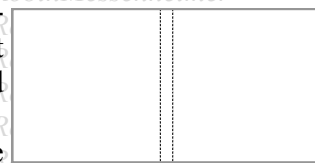
Tea Bag Pockets

1. Score **Designer Paper #1**:
 - 1/2" from one 6-1/2" edge.
 - 3-1/2" from same 6-1/2" edge
 2. Make a tube by folding 1/2" edge in towards the center and the other (3") section in towards the 1/2" fold, apply adhesive and attach ends together.
 2. Score "tube" in from both open ends at 2-7/8" (there will be a 1/4" strip in the middle). Fold on scores and crease with bone folder.
- Using Circle Punch, punch half circle openings on both short ends of tube.



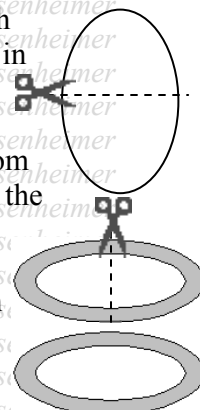
Card/Cover

1. Score **Card Stock #1** at 3-1/2" in from both short edges. Fold on scores and crease with bone folder.
2. Wrap ribbon around outside of card/cover and tie with bow at open ends. Use transparent tape to adhere ribbon to front cover (this will be covered by front decorations).
3. Decorate front, placing **Card Stock #2** with decorations/embellishments over taped ribbon. Use Sizzix Texturz Plate as desired.
4. Using **Sticky Strip**, adhere the **Tea Bag Pocket** to the inside of the card/cover.



Tea Cup and Saucer

1. Punch **Designer Series Paper #2** with **Wide Oval Punch**. Cut punched oval in half. **This is the bowl of the cup.**
2. Punch **Card Stock #3** twice with **Small Oval Punch** leaving enough room to punch around each small oval with the **Large Oval Punch**.
3. Centering the punched **Small Oval** in the **Large Oval Punch** window, punch with the **Large Oval Punch** (for two punched ovals).
4. Punch **Card Stock #3** once more just with the **Large Oval Punch**.
5. To make the cup handle, take the first double punched oval and cut it in half. Arrange the remaining oval shape behind the cup (on the left or right as you prefer).
6. Place the second double punched oval and glue it to the single punched large oval to make the saucer (it will look like the inside is indented as saucers usually are!)



Finishing Touches

Insert tea bags into the two pockets inside the card and tie the ribbon into a bow at the open end.
