

Measurements for Lining Up Three 1-3/8" Circles To Make a Punch Template (Originally for the Little Felt Flurries Trio)

1. Punch out a 1-3/8" circle from card stock.
2. Cut a piece of card stock 5-1/4" x 2-1/4".
3. Measure down 7/16" and draw a line parallel to the top of the card stock. Measure up 7/16" and draw a line parallel to the top of the card stock. These are the **red lines**. The section in the middle will be 1-3/8" high.
4. Measure in from either side 2-5/8" to find the center of the card stock and draw a line from top to bottom (the **green line** in the graphic).
5. Measure 1" on the left of the center line and draw another line parallel to the center line. Do the same on the right of the center line. These are the **blue lines**.
6. Fold the punched circle in half to find the middle. Line up the middle with the **center line**, with the top and the bottom of the circle touching the **top and bottom lines** drawn in step 3. Trace around the circle.
7. Place the punched circle to the left of the **left line** drawn in step 5, with the top and the bottom of the circle touching the top and bottom lines drawn in steps 2 and 3. Trace around the circle. Repeat for the **right side**.
8. Punch the card stock with the 1-3/8" circle punch using the guides that you have just drawn.

To use the template, cut your Designer Series Paper (or card stock) 5-1/4" x 2-1/4". Lay the template on the **BACK** of your paper, and trace the circles onto the paper. Center each drawn circle in your punch opening and punch!
