

# Pop-Up Trio

Lots of fun with these Bears on Surfboards as demonstrated at the Honolulu Regional Seminar in February 2009.  
Thanks to the Hawai'i demonstrator who showed off this technique!

These instructions are for ANY trio of pop ups that you may like to include inside a 5-1/2" x 4-1/4" greeting card. The card illustrated uses the bears from the stamp set, "Under the Stars," and the surfboards from the stamp set, "Just Surfing." The waves and "Surf's Up" are from "Just Surfing," and the sun is from the set, "Just Beachy." The front of this particular card is also from these last two sets. (See bottom right.)

## Materials:

Card stock #1: 5-1/2" x 8-1/2" (Outer Card)

Card stock #2: 5-1/4" x 8-1/4" (Inner Card)

Stamp sets and cut-outs as desired.

## Instructions:

Outer Card: Decorate front of Card Stock #1 as you wish. If you have heavy embellishments, you may wish to leave these until the rest of the card is done.

### Inner Card:

1. Fold Card Stock #2 in half to make a card that's 5-1/4" x 4-1/8"; crease with bone folder.
2. On outside of fold, make a pencil mark 1-1/4" and 2-1/8" in from each side.
3. Fold each outside corner in to make a right angle at the 1-1/4" mark (as shown by red dashed lines on Figure (a)). This starts the crease lines.
4. Clip from the folded edge in 1/2" on the green lines, as shown and fold on the dotted red lines to start the crease lines.
5. Open the card and fold the corners in towards the center. Fold the center cut area in towards the center.
6. Close the card and crease the folds with a bone folder. From the outside your card will look like Figure (b).
7. Again open the card. The folds will look like Figure (c).
8. Attach the images that will pop up to the folded areas shown in gray in Figure (d). I find that it's a good idea to place the figures where they will be attached and fold the card first to make sure that the items will not show over the edge of the card. THEN use adhesive.
9. Once you have finished decorating the inside of the Inner Card, place adhesive as shown in Figure (e) and attach to the inside of the Outer Card.

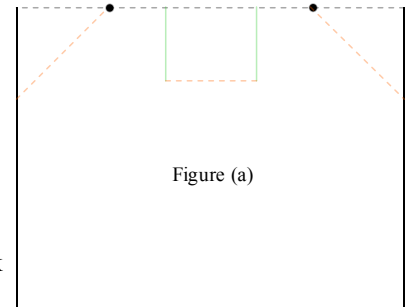

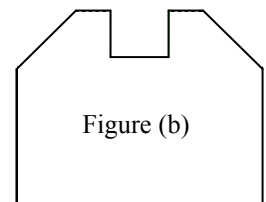

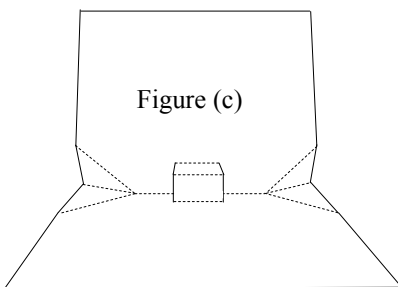

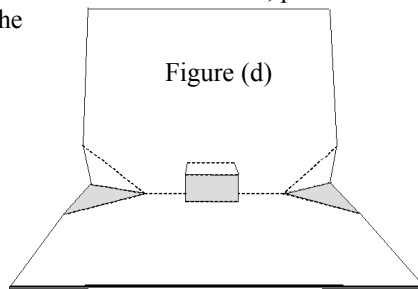
